Molina Healthcare Coding Education Diabetes Mellitus with Other Manifestations



A Type 2 diabetes mellitus with other specified complication diagnosis is used for patients with complications of diabetes other than those associated with ophthalmologic, neurologic, renal, or vascular processes.

Some other manifestations may include but are not limited to:

- Hypertension
- Obesity
- Hyperlipidemia
- Coronary Disease
- Hypoglycemia
- Muscular findings including Dupuytren's contracture
- Skin and nail findings including onychomycosis

Documentation Examples:

Initial Diagnosis

Assessment: 68 year old male with known diabetes presenting with onychomycosis secondary to DM. Improved nail care after extensive podiatry care.

- ➤ **ICD-10 Code**: E11.69 Type 2 diabetes mellitus with other specified complication
- And ICD-10 Code: B35.1 Tinea unguium

Plan: Provide additional education regarding adherence to nail and skin care management, refer to podiatry.

Established Diagnosis

Assessment: 70 year old male with diabetes and hypertension presenting for routine follow up. BP and HTN at goal with current therapy.

- ➤ **ICD-10 Code**: E11.69 Type 2 diabetes mellitus with other specified complication
- And ICD-10 Code: I10 Essential (primary) hypertension

Plan: Continue current management.
