BACKGROUND:

The GeneSight® Psychotropic test is a pharmacogenomic cheek-swab test that analyzes how genetic variations affect an individual's metabolism of medications for depression, anxiety, ADHD, and other psychiatric conditions. The test is not diagnostic. It may be used as a guide for psychotropic medication selection, particularly when patients have had inadequate responses, intolerable side effects, or complex medication histories.

Conditions Covered: GeneSight psychotropic test may assist in medication selection for depression, anxiety, bipolar disorder, PTSD, OCD, schizophrenia and other psychiatric conditions. GeneSight is not diagnostic: It cannot diagnose but rather indicate which medications may better fit a member's genetic profile.

Codes: 0345U

The primary code for the GeneSight® Psychotropic test is CPT code 0345U. This Proprietary Laboratory Analyses (PLA) code specifically covers the 15-gene panel analysis for psychotropic medication metabolism. Provider: The test is performed by Assurex Health Inc. and Myriad Genetics Inc
