Advance Care Planning (ACP)

Measure Description

The percentage of adults 66–80 years of age with advanced illness, an indication of frailty or who are receiving palliative care, and **all** adults 81 years of age and older who had advance care planning during the measurement year.

Ways Providers can Improve HEDIS® Performance

- Document and record the date in the medical record:

- Conversations with the patient, their family, or friends about advance care planning, life-sustaining measures, and end-of-life care during the measurement year.
- Discussions with the patient regarding treatment preferences and the possibility of having a surrogate who can make medical decisions in their place if they are unable to do so.
- That the patient declined to discuss advance care planning as evidence that a discussion was initiated, which meets criteria.
- That the patient had previously signed an Advance Care Plan.
- Schedule telehealth visits to discuss and document conversations with patients, their family, or friends about advance care planning.

Ways Health Plans can Improve HEDIS® Performance

- Member communication about the importance of advanced care planning
- Identify and educate the top 10 providers with open gaps.
- Advanced care planning CPT codes can be independently billed for Medicare part by services by Physicians, advanced practice nurses, physician assistants, and other licensed professionals who are authorized to do so.

Required Exclusions

- Members who use hospice services or elect to use a hospice benefit any time during the measurement period.
- Members who die any time during the measurement year.

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
