HEDIS® Tip Sheet Adult Immunization Status (AIS-E)

Measure Description

The percentage of members 19 years of age and older who are up to date on recommended routine vaccines for influenza, tetanus and diphtheria (Td), or tetanus, diphtheria and acellular pertussis (Tdap), zoster and pneumococcal and hepatitis B.

Influenza

• Members who received an influenza vaccine on or between July 1 of the year prior to the measurement period and June 30 of the measurement period, *or*

• Members with anaphylaxis due to the influenza vaccine any time before or during the measurement period.

<u>Td/Tdap</u>

- Members who received at least one Td vaccine or one Tdap vaccine between 9 years prior to the start of the measurement period and the end of the measurement period, or
- Members with a history of at least one of the following contraindications any time before or during the measurement period:
 - Anaphylaxis due to the diphtheria, tetanus or pertussis vaccine.
 - Encephalitis due to the diphtheria, tetanus or pertussis vaccine.

Zoster

• Members who received two doses of the herpes zoster recombinant vaccine at least 28 days apart, on October 1, 2017, through the end of the measurement period, *or*

• Members with anaphylaxis due to the herpes zoster vaccine any time before or during the measurement period. <u>Pneumococcal</u>

- Members who were administered at least one dose of an adult pneumococcal vaccine on or after the member's 19th birthday and before or during the measurement period, *or*
- Members with anaphylaxis due to the pneumococcal vaccine any time before or during the measurement period.

Hepatitis B

- Members who received at least three doses of the childhood hepatitis B vaccine with different dates of service on or before their 19th birthday, *or*
- Members who received a hepatitis B vaccine series on or after their 19th birthday, before or during the measurement period, *or*
- Members who had a hepatitis B surface antigen, hepatitis B surface antibody or total antibody to hepatitis B core antigen test, with a positive result any time before or during the measurement period, *or*
- Members with a history of hepatitis B illness any time before or during the measurement period. Do not include laboratory claims (POS 81), or
- Members with anaphylaxis due to the hepatitis B vaccine any time during the measurement period.

Ways Providers can Improve HEDIS® Performance

- Review a patient's immunization record before every visit and administer needed vaccinations.
- Educate patients on the importance of vaccinations. Members are more likely to agree with vaccinations when supported by the provider.
- Turn on reminders/prompts for vaccinations, if on EMR. Review vaccination status in EMR.
- Review with new patients any vaccinations that may have been given previously. Include those on the patients' vaccination record even if your office did not provide the vaccination. Schedule appointments for patients to receive immunizations within required timeframes.
- Display vaccine information in multiple languages in office.

Ways Health Plans can Improve HEDIS[®] Performance

- Educate members on the importance of vaccinations.
- Remind members of timing for vaccines.
- Offer adult immunizations at Molina clinic days.
- Ensure access to and utilize state immunization registry files/feeds.
- Identify and educate top 10 providers with open immunization gaps.

Required Exclusions

- Members who use hospice service or elect to use a hospice benefit any time during the measurement period.
- Members who die any time during the measurement period.

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
