Ways Providers can Improve HEDIS® Performance

- Educate members on safety and fall prevention.
- Educate members about the importance of preventive screenings for osteoporosis.
- Document date and type of bone mineral density screening.

Ways Health Plans can Improve HEDIS® Performance

- Educate members about osteoporosis prevention methods, such as calcium, vitamin D supplements, and weight-bearing exercises and the importance of preventive screenings for osteoporosis.
- Recommend and help members schedule osteoporosis screenings.
- Pair osteoporosis screening with mammogram preventive screening; schedule both screenings at once to ensure compliance.
- Review and encourage osteoporosis medication adherence.
- Have culturally appropriate, tailored educational messaging that addresses the risk and importance of
 osteoporosis in racial and ethnic minority populations that have lower screening rates.



Required Exclusions

- Members who use hospice service or elect to use a hospice benefit any time during the measurement period.
- Members who die any time during the measurement year.
- Members who had a claim/encounter for osteoporosis therapy any time in the member's history through December 31 of the year prior to the measurement year.
- Members who had a dispensed prescription to treat osteoporosis any time on or between January 1 three years prior to the measurement year through December 31 of the year prior to the measurement year.
- Members receiving palliative care any time during the measurement year.
- Members who had an encounter for palliative care (ICD-10-CM code Z51.5) any time during the measurement year. Do not include laboratory claims (POS: 81).
- Members 66 years of age and older as of December 31 of the measurement year (all product lines) with frailty
 and advanced illness. Members must meet both frailty and advanced illness criteria to be excluded:
 - Frailty. At least two indications of frailty with different dates of service during the measurement year.
 Do not include laboratory claims (POS: 81).
 - Advanced Illness. Any of the following during the measurement year or the year prior to the measurement year: (a) Advanced illness on at least two different dates of service. Do not include laboratory claims (POS: 81); (b) Dispensed dementia medication.



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
