# HOW TO IMPROVE HEDIS SCORES ☐ Use appropriate billing codes as described above. ☐ Document all elements of a preventive exam including health history, developmental history, physical exam and education/anticipatory guidance. ☐ Educate patients on the importance of having at least one ambulatory or preventive care visit during each calendar year. ☐ Contact patients on the needed services list who have not had a preventive or ambulatory health visit. ☐ Look into offering expanded office hours to increase access to care. ☐ Make reminder calls to patients who have appointments to decrease no-show rates.
